Political Profile:

1988 - A soft spoken economist joined politics after being conferred Doctorate in Economics from the prestigious NEHU, and was firstly elected to the 4th MLA as an Independent Candidate with the ardent support of the then Alliance Reconstruction of Meghalaya State, a political body of the Khasi Students' Union. His Symbol is the "Drum".

1989 - Nominated as Member of the Privilege Committee, MLA. Was the Minister of State in (L) B.B. Lyngdoh Ministry and served in various capacities in the state.

1990 - Cabinet Minister (Health & Family Welfare) - (United Meghalaya Parliamentary Forum led by P.A Sangma.

26- 03-90 - Resigned from the Council of Minister. He along with other MLAs withdrew as members of the United Meghalaya Parliamentary Forum and joined the UNITED MEGHALAYA PARLIAMENTARY FORUM (B) formed under the leadership of Shri B.B- Lyngdoh comprising of 21 members namely 1 . B.B. Lyngdoh 2. H.B. Dan 3. S.P. Swer 4. A. Lyngdoh 5. M. Agitok 6. J.M. Pariat. 7. Beningstand G. Momin. 8. Dentist M.R. Kharkongor 9. S.L. Marbaniang. 10. Chesterfield W. Marak 11. Luderberg Ch. Momin. 12. Projend D. Sangma 13- S.M. Sangma 14. Chamberlain Marak 15. H.D.R. Lyngdoh 16. Nimarson Momin 17. Clifford R. Marak 18. S. Siangshai 19. Donkumar Roy. 20. Mrs. M.D. Shira 21. 1991 - Disqualified from being Member of the MLA (on the alleged ground of defecting from his party/alliance and Joining the HSPDP (DL) alongwith 2 other members namely Mrs. M.D. Shira, (3) Shri Simon Siangshai . However, appealed to the Supreme Court who set aside the ruling of the Speaker .

1993 - Re-elected.

1997 – Co- founded of the United Democratic Party alongwith (L) B.B. Lyngdoh, (L) E.K. Mawlong and its assigned symbol is the “Drum”.

1998 - Re-elected. Cabinet Minister (Education).

1999 - Cabinet Minister (Health & Family Welfare)

2000 - 2001 - *Cabinet* Minister (Health & Family Welfare)

2001 - Cabinet Minister (Finance). No Confidence Motion against the E.K Mawlong Government.

2002 - Cabinet Minister (Health, Education)

2003 - Re-elected Deputy Chief Minister (Power, Finance)

2005 - 2007 - Deputy Chief Minister (Revenue, Education, Power)

2008 - Re-elected and eventually realized his political dreams after being sworn in as Chief Minister.

2009 - His government was dismissed. Congress under the leadership of Dr. D.D Lapang came back into power.

Supported the Congress led Government.

2009 - 2012 - Held the post of Chairman - State Planning Board.

2013 - Re-elected to the 9th MLA & Held the post of Leader of Opposition till 2017.

2018 - Re-elected to the 10th MLA & held the post of Speaker.
